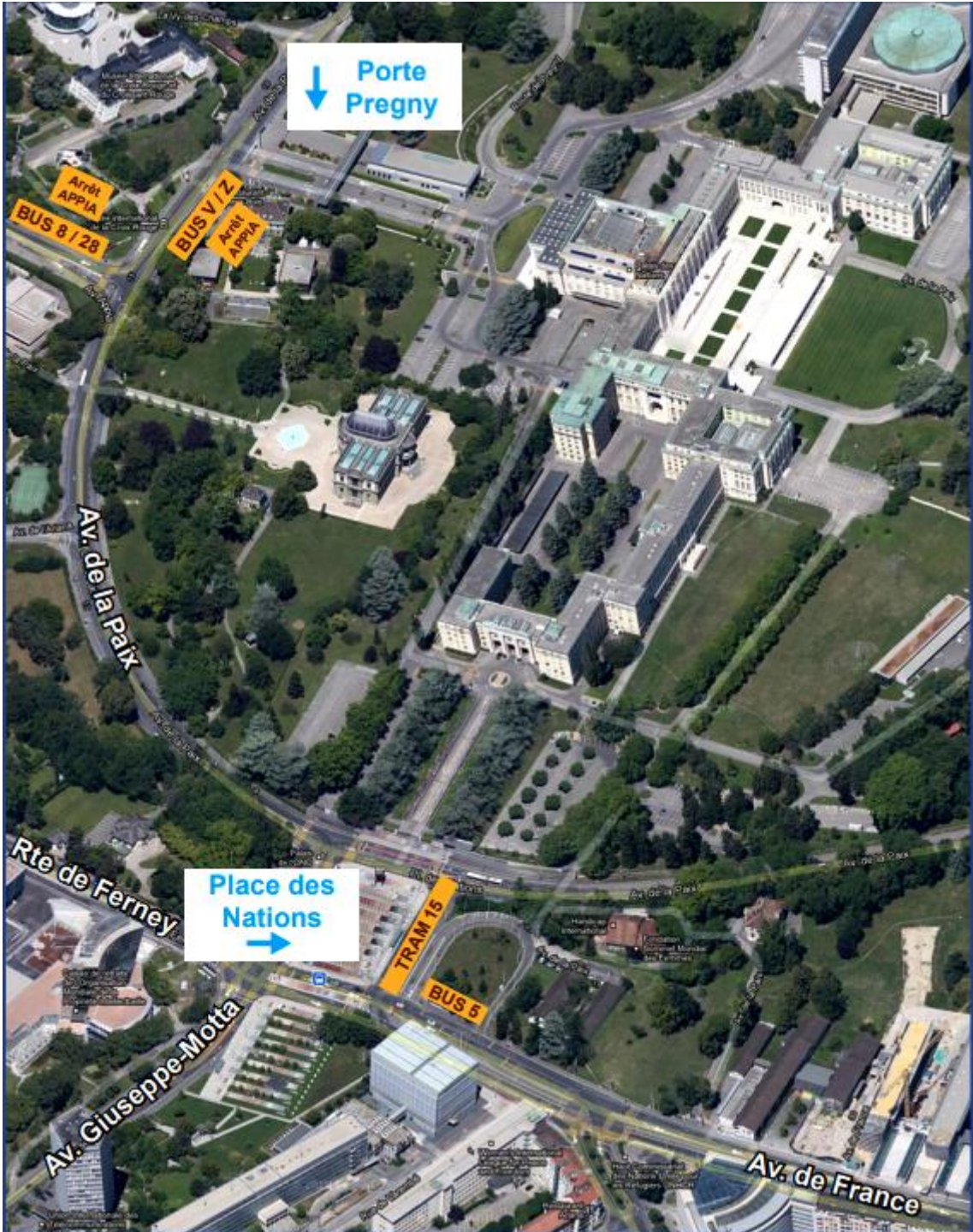

 **BUS 11** Richtung Genève, Bout-du-Monde

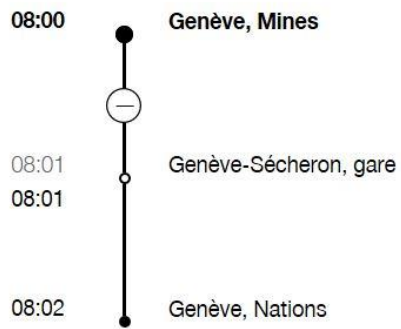

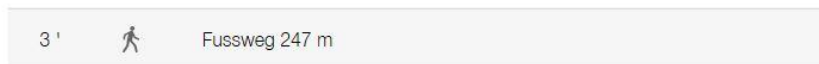

The Maison de la Paix, Chemin Eugène-Rigot 2, 1202 Genève, Switzerland



The Maison de la Paix (literally: House of Peace) is a building owned by the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies in Geneva, Switzerland. It serves as the new headquarters for the Graduate Institute and houses the three Geneva Centres, which comprise the Geneva Centre for Security Policy (GCSP), the Geneva International Centre for Humanitarian Demining (GICHD), and the Geneva Centre for the Democratic Control of Armed Forces (DCAF).
